My Dear Friends,

Last Sunday I announced the outcome of Kuncoro's 'transitioning deacons' interview with the Archbishop and his advisers. We give thanks to God that the Archbishop has indicated that he intends to ordain Kuncoro as a priest in the church, at **10.30am on Saturday 28 November**, in St Paul's Cathedral. I know that we will all want to be there – be sure to arrive early, as the Cathedral is likely to be full that day. Afterwards, we will be able celebrate with Kun, **3-5pm** in the Rutherford Room.

Kun and the others to be ordained that day will enter the pre-ordination retreat on Wednesday 25 November. I know that we will all be holding Kun in our prayers during this time. And not only Kun, but also Mun, and Rama and Arielle. An ordination affects the whole family!

During these next few weeks Kun will be focussing on preparing himself not only for the ordination, but also for his first presiding at the Eucharist, at **10am on Advent Sunday, 29 November** – then for the second time at the **3pm Eucharist** that day.

This will be a most significant rite of passage in Kun's life, of course. And it will be a momentous development in the life of St John's Camberwell. The parish has made a very substantial commitment to the development of the Indonesian ministry – in the direct ministry costs of having a full-time curate, and in the many indirect costs associated with supporting Kun's formation and the formation of the 3pm congregation as Anglicans, and as participants in the life of this particular Anglican parish.

In the new liturgical year we can expect to see Kun's liturgical and pastoral role develop. And this development invites our deepening engagement and participation.

As we are aware, one of Parish Council's goals for 2015 is for **working together as one parish**. On Trinity Sunday I wrote: "An area where I think we all need to make a much greater effort is in building relationships between the 3pm congregation and 8am and 10am. I encourage all of us to make the effort to worship with each other from time to time. Anglican spiritual life is formed primarily by prayer – we are 'prayer book people' – so we really need to pray with each other. We will grow together by praying together." I am grateful to those from 8am and 10am who have made the effort since then to worship with the 3pm congregation. For those who have not yet done so, I encourage and warmly invite you to prayerfully consider this. This bold venture requires not only our prayerful support, but our meaningful engagement.
