Feast of All Saints—2 November 2014

The thanksgiving for the ministry of Bishop Barbara Darling, Bishop of the Eastern Region

Last Sunday at 2pm more than 300 attendees, including a dozen representatives from St John's, gathered for a Eucharist at St Mark's Camberwell to give thanks for the ministry of Bishop Barbara Darling, bishop of the Eastern Region, as she retires from full-time Episcopal ministry. Those who gathered acknowledged her wonderful contribution to the Diocese, first as a deacon, then a priest and finally as a bishop. Our former director of music, John Lester, directed the choir, gathered from the many congregations of the Eastern region, who led the hymns, the psalm and sang communion anthems.

Archbishop Philip joined the congregation, acknowledging Bishop Barbara's work among the Episcopate, thanking her for all her work and her ministry since her consecration in 2008, and her leadership in the Eastern region since 2009. In addition, representatives for the clergy and laity of the region spoke to give thanks to Bishop Barbara, all recognising the many gifts which she brought to her ministry.

Bishop Barbara, the second female bishop in Australia and the first in Victoria, is a pioneer among the clergy. She was among the first group of women ordained as deacons and again when they were able to be ordained as priests. As one of these women, she has led the way for subsequent generations called to ministry.

A montage of photographs from her time as a Bishop spoke to the breadth of her ministry. Many of them were greeted with smiles and gentle laughter at the joyous moments they depicted. Photographs showed Bishop Barbara at her consecration as a bishop; at confirmations, laying hands on those who had reaffirmed the promises made at their baptism; also at receptions, welcoming into the Anglican Church those who have been baptised at other denominations; and at the February 2013 ordination service where she acted as vicar-general while Archbishop Philip was on leave – the first time a woman has ordained clergy here in Victoria.

Here at St John's, we give thanks for Bishop Barbara's presence with us at services of confirmation and reception into the Anglican Church, her Episcopal visits at which she preached and presided at the Eucharist and led us in worship, and for her leadership among us, consistently preaching a message of faith, hope and love in the name of Christ.

Thanks be to God for the faithful ministry of Bishop Barbara, and the inspiration it provides us all.
