Dear Friends,

No, there are no 'typos' in the reproduction of today's poem. As it used to be said in the early days of television, 'Do not adjust your set!' Everything you see here was intended by the poet. As Janet Morley observed, E E Cummings was 'well known for the wild, or absent punctuation and bizarre word order.' And how apt, given the subject of today's celebration and the season of Resurrection! Resurrection itself is something wild, whose punctuation defies our demands for neat and orderly structure, whose very mode is bizarre. Resurrection defies rather more than locked doors!

Resurrection domesticated by orderliness, though – including our 'decent and orderly' Anglican liturgies – is hardly Resurrection at all. Janet Morley again: 'This is an event that demands to be described and celebrated, yet it strains and cracks open ordinary human language.' Thomas makes a perfectly sensible demand to see the marks of the nails and the pierced side of the risen Christ. Thomas then models the awakening of ears and the opening of eyes which are the foundation of the declaration of faith: 'My Lord, and my God!' Impossible... a new dimension of humanity whose only power is self-emptying love? Yes, possible. Indeed, the infinite future.

Yet even such a declaration is an empty phrase, unless we ourselves experience being lifted from the 'no of all nothing'. How will we know we are lifted (Greek: *anastēnai*, 'to rise up')? We will live out of the liberty of the One who is no longer bound, when we give our lives away, freed to love beyond the boundaries of fear and anxiety, to forgive, to be at peace.
