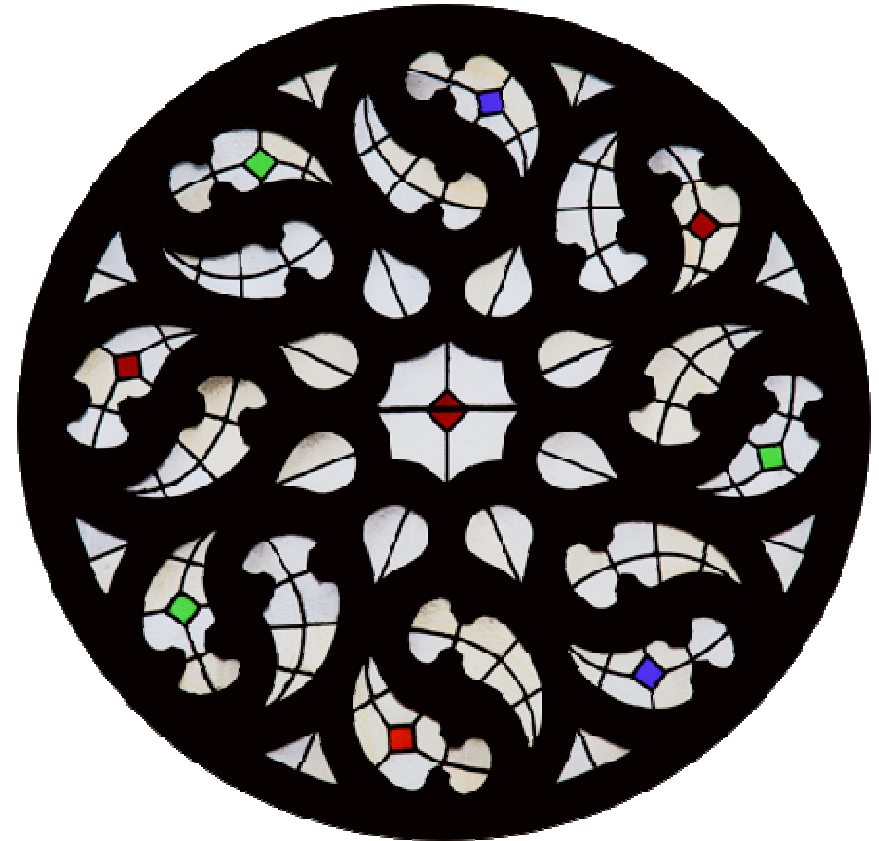

Christian representations of the Divine Oneness are found in the rose windows in church buildings, such as the two rose windows in the transepts at St John's (as reproduced above). The rose window is concentric, a circle composed of many parts, varying in style and complexity and colour, but in every case a symbol of the integration of the separate parts into wholeness, one-ness. In the words of Gregory of Nyssa (335-394CE), a Unity that "blends and harmonises things (which are ordinarily) mutually opposed, so that many things become one."
