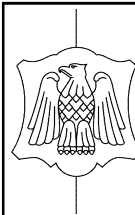

PARISH SYNOD REPRESENTATIVES – CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

With a new Diocesan Synod being established this year, the first year of a three-year cycle, the Archbishop has issued a mandate for the election of parish lay representatives. (The licensed parish clergy are already Synod members *ex officio*.)

St John's is entitled to elect three Synod representatives and one alternate – that is, a 'spare' who can step in if one of the three elected is not available to attend one of the annual synod meetings.

The deadline for election of our representatives is very tight! Nominations, on the prescribed forms, need to be handed to the parish office by **5pm next Friday, 14 June**. The nominations will then be on display next Sunday, 16 June, with an election to be held on the following Sunday, 23 June, if there are more nominations than vacancies.

Anyone who is at least 18 years old and is a Communicant of the Anglican Church of Australia, is eligible to be nominated. They must be nominated by five people enrolled on the electoral roll of this parish.

Nomination forms are available in the narthex today. Synod plays a crucial role in the governance of our church, and being a lay member of Synod is a very important commitment. Please give careful consideration either to seeking nomination yourself, or nominating someone. Speak to Fr John if you need more information.

St John's 'Parish Covenant' is the basis for all relationships, social interactions, and patterns of behaviour within and concerning the Parish. It is on display in the narthex and available on the parish website. All parishioners are encouraged to sign the Covenant, demonstrating their public commitment to a safe and healthy parish community.
