20 SUGGESTIONS FOR LENT

- . Go out of your way to help others.
- 2. Make an extra sacrifice by giving more each week at Church or make an additional offering via the ABM Lenten envelopes.
- 3. Commit to attending one of the mid-week Services or simply spend some time in silent prayer each day.
- 4. Join the Lenten Studies on Sundays at 11.30am and Tuesdays at 12.30pm.
- 5. Invite someone or others around for a meal who you have been meaning to spend time with for ages.
- 6. Identify someone who is lonely and do something about it.
- 7. Do you know someone who is unemployed'? Can you help him or her?
- 8. Have you been less than honest in how you feel towards someone? Have you been harbouring resentment or ill feelings. Try to address this situation.
- 9. Avoid television for a week. See what affect it has on you and your family.
- 10. Do you know someone suffering mentally, physically, spiritually at present? Do something practical to support them.
- 11. Attend Morning or Evening prayer.
- 12. Buy or obtain a book of prayers or spiritual reflections. The clergy can provide some suggestions.
- 13. Buy a commentary on one of the Gospels and study the story of Jesus in detail.
- 14. Are you indecisive about something? Make a decision!
- 15. Eat simply one day per week in Lent and make a donation to ABM.
- 16. Walk more regularly. Drive the car less. Use less fuel. Help the environment.
- 17. Despite what you think about many of our leaders and politicians, try praying for them.
- 18. Examine those things which most occupy your time and interest and attempt to minimize the time you give to them.
- 19. Do you know of a family that needs support? Help them!
- 20. Join the clergy as they plan to 'Loiter in Lent' change to our normal routine by "loitering within Lent" spending time together in some unfamiliar and familiar places, making time to learn and to see differently.
