Dear Friends,

In a marvellous reflection published this Easter the English priest-philosopher Giles Fraser has written:

The resurrection is not an argument, still less a philosophical argument. That's why rational scepticism about the empty tomb just bounces off the surface. As Jonathan Swift was right to say, you can't reason people out of something they weren't reasoned into. The resurrection is more an identity than an argument. That's why we turn it into participatory theatre, with incense and candles. It is who we are – our word for how we go on in the face of overwhelming odds. It's the Christian term for defiance. This Easter rising is not just some fancy intellectual idea, it's a form of praxis.

The poet and the philosopher-priest remind us not to get lost in the superficial detail and dry argument: the ever-present danger of a Christianity neurotically defending rational resurrection doctrines (which Jesus himself would not recognise!) instead of undergoing the praxis of resurrection. This is not mere hunger. This is resurrection! This is an exuberant meal for everyone, selflessly shared, even with betrayers, with those most despised and hated even. Resurrection is the Christian term for defiance. Not a fancy idea, but a form of radical praxis! Wounds and salt for a fearful little Church. Giles Fraser again:

I know the Church of England is supposed to be dying. And there are those who want to save it with cod management theory and evangelical up-speak. But if we as a church really believe in death and resurrection, then we don't really need any of that secular sorcery.
