Greetings

As I do not live locally it seemed best to change the time of Morning Prayer during the week from 8.30 to 9.30, this allows me to travel to St. John's as the volume of traffic decreases rather than trying to travel here when most other people are using the roads. The Daily Services provide opportunities for prayer, scripture reading and reflection. Most members of the community are not able to attend these services however all of the community can be aware that this spiritual discipline occurs at this time following a regular pattern and can be connected to it, through prayer and reflection regardless of location. If you are able to attend your presence will be valued and enjoyed. On the days that I am at St. John's during the week [Tuesdays & Wednesdays] I usually bring along some coffee grounds; if you can attend and have time to have coffee with me you will be warmly welcomed.

We are very privileged to live in a society where respect for other people is widely maintained and valued. This environment can only be maintained and sustained in our community if we have a strong commitment to each other and if we are open in our willingness to understand each other's personal story. The social life of our whole community is enriched through a liberal approach in our attitudes that is marked by acceptance of those who are different to us or whose lives are different to our life's experience. The human family shares much that is common to all people thus making the differences that do exist both manageable and acceptable. Let us rejoice in both, all that we have in common with each other and let us also celebrate our differences thus making it possible for the whole community to be enriched by our acceptance of each other and by how we value each other.
