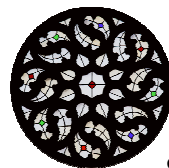

Dear Friends,

Breaking from this Lent's pattern of front page poetry, this week I write with some important ministry information, and some very exciting news.

Our Children's and Family Minister, Clare Tomasov, recently advised me that she would like to relinquish her work with the Little Seeds Playgroup at the end of term 2 this year. Clare initiated this outreach ministry about 8 years ago, and, with the support of a wonderful team of parish volunteers, this ministry has assisted and encouraged many young families. It's a very demanding work, requiring a high level of physical and emotional energy. Clare has reached that point of knowing that, after 8 years, her energies for this particular ministry are depleted, and that it's time for a fresh energy to take on that particular work. Clare's work with our parish children and families will continue, with one day less per week. Parish Council has agreed that we will now undertake a search for a suitably qualified person to be employed by St John's for 1 day per week to undertake this ministry, for the remainder of 2016.

Why that timing? It has been on our mind that it's also time for us to review our children's and families ministry, there having not been a review in the approximately 10 years since it commenced. This review will be undertaken under my oversight – once I am fully recovered from my recent cycling misadventure – and will involve all 'stakeholders', including our parish families and the Little Seeds Playgroup families. In the mean time, there is no change to the parish's commitment to children's and families ministry.

Lastly, I am delighted to be able to report that Clare has begun a process of deeper ministry discernment, exploring the possibility that God may be calling her into ordained ministry. I can attest from my own experience that such an exploration is a major disruption in a person's life. During last year's consideration of the Contemplative Community Proposal I spoke often about the centrality of the spiritual work the church calls 'discernment'. As the Lenten journey we are all undergoing now reminds us, discernment does not guarantee outcomes – other than more faithfully obeying the 'Spirit who blows where she will'. I know we will all want to pray for Clare as she participates in the Diocese's 'Year of Discernment', as she continues to minister among us. For it's in the midst of our mutual ministry to each other that Clare seeks to discern God's will for her. I know that, given our Mission Action Plan's emphasis on being a parish that 'encourages vocations to the ordained ministry', it will be a matter of deep joy for us all that one among us is willing to take the risk of such a search.
