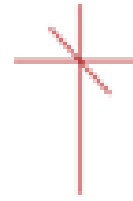

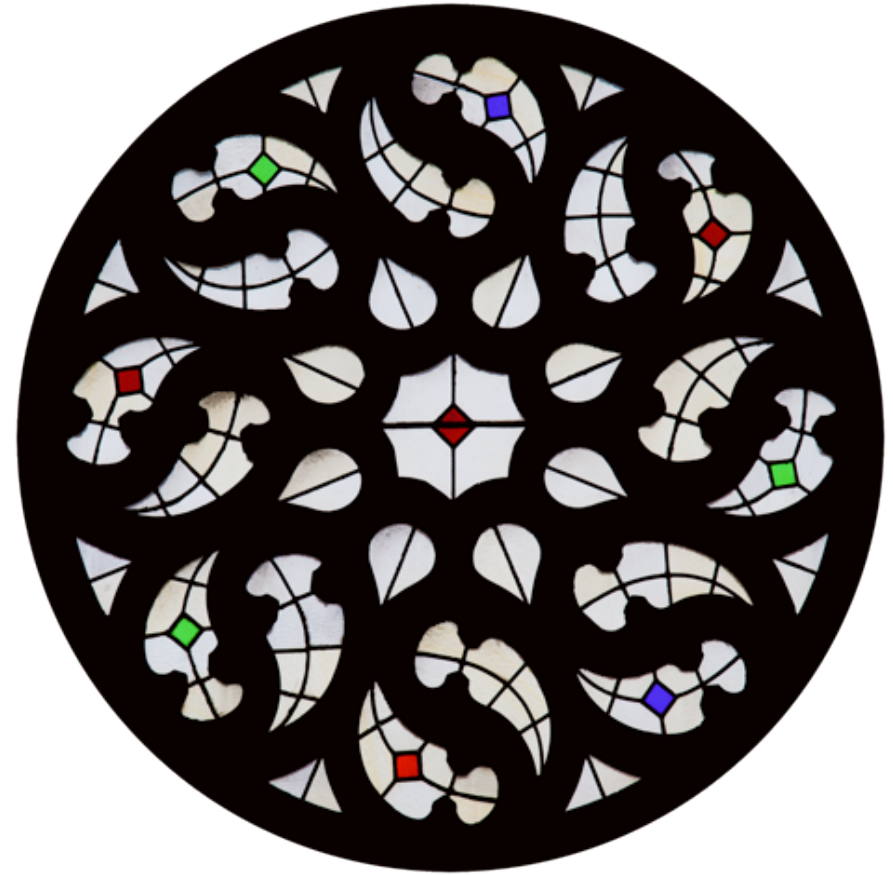
Morning Prayer will now be said at **9am** each weekday morning, including Mondays. Evening prayer will also be said each weekday evening at 5pm, including Mondays.

Spring Series second session today

The second session of our Spring Series – ‘From here to Eternity – living, dying and grieving well’ – follows the 10am Sung Eucharist this morning. The session will last about an hour.

This morning our main speaker will be Dr Barbara Hayes, Chair of Palliative Care Victoria. Dr Hayes is a palliative care physician who is also involved in advanced care planning. Parishioner Lynn Goodall will also be speaking. Lynn's background is in nursing, palliative care, Spiritual Direction and Advocacy.

Again there will be a resources table, with some additional material available today, including copies of Canon Dr O'Reilly's excellent address at last Sunday's session.

Please note that that some people might find today's session distressing. If you are concerned but still wish to attend, please feel free to leave the session at any time. The clergy on hand will also be able to offer pastoral care.

Next Sunday

Our Vicar will be the speaker at the third and final session. He brings his many years as a parish priest ministering to people facing critical life issues. Fr John has also known the loss of a partner, when his wife died at the age of 30, from cancer – an experience that has shaped his life and ministry ever since.

All are welcome to these sessions – you might know some friends or neighbours who would find the series helpful.
