The response to the implementation of the Child Safety Code of Conduct has been very encouraging and positive, thank you for your cooperation. The need to implement this code can be viewed as contributing to our being empowered for service in the life of the church and the community.

Christ has taught us that as Christians we are expected to bear fruit, and this fruitfulness is the sign that any Christian is filled with the Spirit, whether through baptism, confirmation or empowering prayer. Child safety in the parish: TIME IS RUNNING OUT!

There are still quite a number of parishioners in specific ministry roles who have not yet signed their commitment to the Diocese's Child Safety Code of Conduct in front of a designated parish witness. This can be done this morning after the 10am service, or on the next two Sundays, 22 and 29 July. To continue in these roles, the commitment must be signed by **1 August** at the latest.

Parishioners whose ministry roles also now require them to have Working with Children and/or Police checks under the Diocese's new Child Safety regulations should by now have received a letter from the Parish Administrator outlining their requirements. The Office Assistant, Mrs Laura Hewitson, is available to help with applications for these checks. Parishioners seeking her help **MUST** make an appointment either by email (assistant@stjohnscamberwell.org.au) or by phoning the parish office (9882 4851). When you make your booking, you will be advised of the ID requirements you need to bring.

These checks must at least be in process by 1 August.
