Dear Friends,

Last year, we initiated the inaugural 'Feast of Corpus Christi Lecture', devoted to promoting contemplative ways of knowing and living. Our Associate Priest, The Reverend Dr Michelle Trebilcock, spoke about love in liminality.

This year we have invited Pádraig Ó Tuama, leader of the Corrymeela Community in Belfast, to speak about 'the gift of being gay'. We were delighted when he suggested the topic 'This is My Body: Stories from the edges on the Feast of Corpus Christi.'

The body of Christ (Latin: *Corpus Christi*) demands a more-than-logical rationality to truly understand it - being simultaneously and always the humanity of Jesus, the communion of saints, and the sacramental bread.

Pádraig, a poetic story-teller who embodies theology, is well placed to take us further into the mystery of the Body of Christ. He is deeply affirming of all those who find themselves 'at the edges' and uses his lyrical gifts to teach and promote reconciliation practices in a wide variety of contexts, most especially religious, political, and sexuality. The celebration of the Eucharist prior to the lecture, with an emphasis on space and silence in the liturgy, intentionally sets the mode of listening and learning. *All* are very welcome. We hope that our invitation might reach many who have not felt welcomed at a celebration of the body of Christ for some time.

As we celebrate today the gift of the Holy Spirit, it is fitting that our focus is directed towards those who the church has marginalized – none more so in our time than those who identify as something other than 'heterosexual'. We celebrate that the Holy Spirit is poured out on all flesh, on all people, regardless of any distinction we humans have been able to construct. We celebrate that in Christ all are one: all of the one Body; all are one new creation by water and Spirit in the waters of death and resurrection; all eat of the one Bread, drink of the one Cup; all gathered equally and without distinction around the one Altar.

Come, Holy Spirit!
