# ST JOHN'S ANGLICAN CHURCH, CAMBERWELL Pentecost 22—October 16 2016

Dear Friends.

In our liturgy today we will have an experience of worship without booklets. The only words that will be available in the worship today are the hymns. Everything else we are invited to pray from the heart. We do actually know these prayers: we've been praying them for years. We are invited to look up, to see each other around the Table as the living 'Body of Christ', to pay attention to the principal symbols of our Eucharistic life together. Our hands are free. Our eyes are liberated to really look, to notice, to gaze. We begin to hear the words of Sacred Scripture not as mere words on a page, but, with the ears of the heart, as living images. As the Orthodox say, putting the mind in the heart!

Today's liturgical experience is a part of our annual whole-of-parish education and formation Spring Series, 'Prayer in Daily Life'. Over these four Sundays we are reflecting on prayer: what it *is*, what it is *not*; how it can be fostered, how it can be thwarted; what are our hopes and desires, what are our anxieties and neuroses; how prayer transforms us as those who are coming alive in the Spirit. It builds on our 2015 Series, when we focussed on our liturgical life, on the fact that liturgy is not primarily a reading exercise. *Liturgy is not words*. Rather, as the word 'liturgy' makes explicit, it's a 'work' of the people. In other words, liturgy is primarily an action, a doing, an undergoing, an experience, an encounter. When the words take over and become the centre of attention, encounter is displaced by formalism, literalism, rationalism, legalism.

Yes, I realise that we all come to this with our anxieties and fears. I realise that many of us were taught in Sunday Schools that praying means getting all the words right, exactly. Yes, I am aware that for some of us, we are almost terrified of feeling exposed: what if my friends see that I don't seem to have memorised every single word of the Creed! I will feel such shame! Yes, I am aware that some of us have inherited a centuries-long fallacy that praying means clutching a book, and that without something to hold in our hands we feel exposed, insecure. Yes, I am aware that some of us regard Scripture as words to be intellectually processed.

Yes, I am well aware of all this. I would simply encourage us to do two things: to be very honest and own our strong feeling reactions, which are revealing us to ourselves; and to turn back to the Jesus of the gospels. In Jesus we will discover 'life in abundance', the 'easy yoke', ourselves as 'infants' to whom it has been revealed that the 'letter kills' but the 'Spirit gives life', who are carried on what one writer has called "the ocean of God's connectedness". And let's relax a bit - it's OK to enjoy God's ocean.
