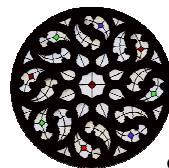

The Moment

The moment when, after many years of hard work and a long voyage you stand in the centre of the room, house, half-acre, square mile, island, country, knowing at last how you got there, and say, *I own this*,

is the same moment the trees unloose their soft arms from around you, the birds take back their language, the cliffs fissure and collapse, the air moves back from you like a wave and you can't breathe.

No, they whisper, You own nothing.

You were a visitor, time after time

climbing the hill, planting the flag, proclaiming.

We never belonged to you.

You never found us.

It was always the other way round.

Dear Friends,

In this Holy Week poem Margaret Atwood invites us to reflect on those ways in which we make claims which are inevitably inflated and misguided. Everything we claim as possession is mirage: in truth all is God's, grace on loan. 'You own nothing... You never found us.' John's Jesus echoes down the millennia: 'You did not choose me; I chose you.'

The Gospel's stories of this momentous week recapitulate and condense the entire spiritual task - which none can ultimately evade. We see Jesus, the 'pioneer and completer of our salvation', tempted as we are. After years of hard ministry work with these people, surely he's entitled to stand in the centre of Jerusalem and lay claim to it as his own? No! He must resist and emphatically reject the claims of the ego: 'Not my will, but yours.' No kingdom over which to lay claim. No 'success'. No followers to stand by him. Nowhere to lay his head. Rather, he simply belongs to Love.

The rhythm, the liturgies, symbols, silences, darkness and light of Holy Week and the Sacred Easter Triduum are the faith community's gift to us: a moment, to give ourselves to *Love who finds us*.

EASTER TRIDUUM

DOROTHY LEE OUR TRIDUUM

PREACHER: We are privileged to be welcoming The Revd Canon Professor Dorothy Lee, Dean of Trinity College Theological School, as our preacher for the Triduum. Dorothy, an internationally acclaimed New Testament scholar, will preach at the liturgies on Holy Thursday (8pm), Good Friday (9.30am), and Easter Day (both 6am and 10am).

HOLY THURSDAY 8PM & NIGHT-WATCH OF PRAYER: After the stripping of the Altar and Reservation of the Sacrament on Holy Thursday we keep watch with Christ **ALL NIGHT** in the chapel. Christ still asks us: "Can you keep watch with me?"

GOOD FRIDAY: Please note that the Liturgy of the Cross is at **9.30am**. The **Ecumenical Walk** immediately follows it commencing at OLV at 11.15am. There is no afternoon liturgy on Good Friday.

EASTER VIGIL: 6AM—This is the Christian liturgy. All Christian worship is derived from this great liturgical action. There is nothing else like it. It requires effort - and transforms those who make it. The parish community that commits itself to this and the whole celebration of the Easter Triduum is a transformed community

If you have never experienced this great celebration in its entirety, which begins in the dark of Thursday evening and literally ushers in the light of Easter morning, I encourage you to consider doing so this year. Fr David.
