Since last Christmas we have been preparing ourselves for the long-awaited whole-of-parish education-formation Spring Series on liturgy and mission:

## Our Worship : Our Faith : Our Mission

### October Sundays 4, 11, 18, 25

11.30am-1pm, including bring your own lunch

I have been asked, what's it all about?

That giant of 20<sup>th</sup> century theology Hans Kung declared: "The liturgy is and remains the centre of the life of the church. If this can successfully be renewed, won't that also have effects on all the areas of church activity?"

Church of England priest and author of *Re-Pitching the Tent: the definitive guide to reordering church buildings for worship and mission*, Richard Giles, writes: "The way the church does liturgy... will exert an enormous impact on both our understanding of God and our ability to share the good news."

Reflecting on Christian worship, Archbishop Rowan Williams observes: "The [liturgy] requires us not to belong any more to the categories we thought we belonged in, so that a distinctive kind of new belonging can be realized."

Our Mission Action Plan's goal # 1 is 'Stimulating Spiritual Vitality', its goal #2 is 'Liturgical Renewal'.

With all this in mind, the Spring Series will invite us to reflect on the connection between our liturgical practice, our proclamation, and our mission as the baptized. The Four sessions will be:

**RITUAL & BUILDINGS:** What are we saying?

**FONT:** How did we get here?

**LECTERN:** What's our story?

**ALTAR-TABLE:** Becoming what we eat?

In each of the sessions I will present some teaching on liturgy, theology, and mission, and members of the planning group will present personal reflections. There will be both small group and plenary discussion. I look forward to our explorations.
