Night-Watch of Prayer

In the hours between the Holy Thursday Last Supper and the Good Friday Liturgy of the Cross Christians are invited to **journey with Jesus** - in his agony in the garden of Gethsemane, his arrest, his humiliations, beatings and trials before religious and political leaders. With Christ enter into the world’s suffering and agony, here and now as much as there and then. This year, for the first time, we will keep the Night-Watch of Prayer **ALL NIGHT from 9.30pm Holy Thursday until 9.30am Good Friday**. This is a beautiful and transformative ancient spiritual practice. It’s an opportunity to experience a sustained contemplative silence with Christ in the depth of the world’s night, intimately with each other, and with the Communion of Saints around the world. It is important to sign up on the roster in the church. Invite others to consider this also. The night is divided into 1hour slots. We need to ensure that there will be a **minimum of 2 persons** at any time. If you have any questions, speak with the Vicar.
