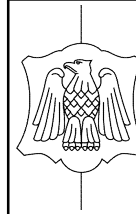

To praise thy name:

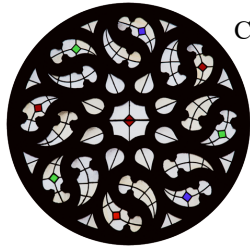
That if I chance to hold my peace,
