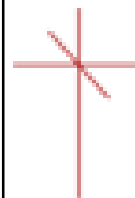

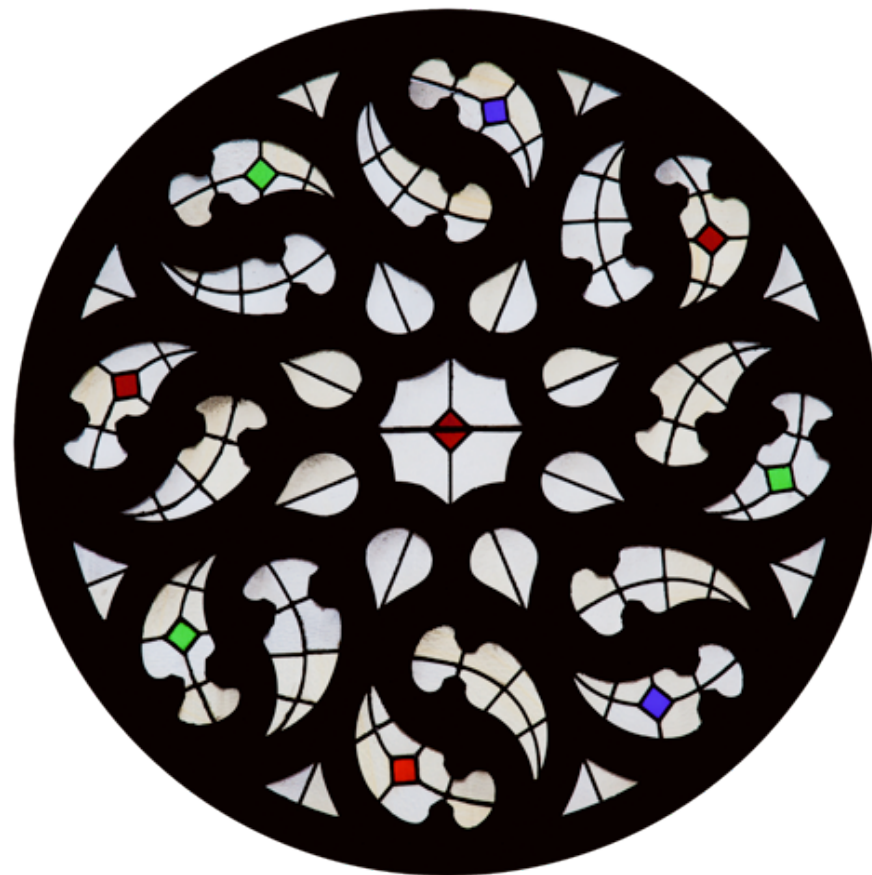

ESTONIA—THE LAST HUNDRED YEARS: MEETING POSTPONED UNTIL MONDAY 1 OCTOBER

The next meeting of the Anglicare Partnership Group will now be held on Monday, 1 October at 2.15pm in the Rutherford Room.

The guest speakers will be Glenis and Don Heath, and their topic will feature Estonia where their son has lived and worked over the last sixteen years. All are welcome.

'FROM HERE TO ETERNITY'

This year's Spring Series, 'From here to Eternity – living, dying and grieving well', begins on Sunday 7 October, continuing on the following two Sundays, 14 and 21 October. The sessions, each lasting only about an hour, follow the Sung Eucharist at 11.30am.

We have some excellent speakers to help us reflect spiritually on the end-of-life issues we rarely speak about, as well as to offer some important practical information and resources.

The main speaker at the first session will be the Revd Canon Dr Colleen O'Reilly, the Vicar of St George's Malvern, and well-known to many in this parish. Her doctoral thesis looked at the ways in which Christian rites serve pastoral needs, as in the way the funeral service is an essential rite of passage for both the dead person, and the mourners if they are to live well with the loss. She teaches clergy how to make effective use of Anglican rites, and enables people to appreciate how the funeral service expresses faith in the God of transformed life and meets pastoral need in a confusing time.

For the second session, we are very fortunate to have secured as our main speaker Dr Barbara Hayes, a palliative care physician who is also involved in advanced care planning. Dr Hayes is an Anglican.

The third session will be led by the Vicar, who brings his many years as a parish priest ministering to people facing critical life issues. Fr John has also known the loss of a partner, when his wife died at the age of 30, from cancer – an experience that has shaped his life and ministry ever since.

All are welcome to these sessions – you might know some friends or neighbours who would find the series helpful.
