Feast of Mary Magdalene—23 July 2017

They have taken away my Lord

BISHOP TAYLOR RETIRING: Our former Vicar, Bishop Alison Taylor, is retiring to Melbourne at the end of the year. Alison has been Bishop for the Southern Region in Queensland since her consecration in Brisbane in April 2013. Next year she will begin doctoral research, through Trinity College Theological School, into theology related to the work of the Royal Commission into Institutional Responses to Child Sexual Abuse – an area described by Archbishop Phillip Aspinall as of “ongoing vital importance to the Church”. Archbishop Aspinall has expressed his gratitude “for her wonderful episcopal ministry”, adding that her “pastoral care and theological insight have been greatly valued” not only by him but “by all to whom she has ministered”.
