Dear Friends,

As you will have read last week, Parish Council has decided to support **Trinity College Theological School's 'Faith in Our Future' appeal**. Today's Contact includes an appeal envelope. Let me explain why this is important to St John's, and the Diocese.

The future of Trinity College Theological School is critical to parishes such as St John's. It educates and forms catholic Anglican clergy, the clergy we need to ensure the continuation of a corporate life cherishing word and sacrament, grounded in prayer and worship, committed to compassion and justice, welcoming people of all ages, gender, race, colour, creed and sexual orientation. There are now only a handful of theological colleges around Australia that prepare ordination candidates for parishes like ours, so Trinity's future is vital.

The Dean of the Theological School, the Reverend Canon Professor Dorothy Lee has long been a friend of this parish. In launching the annual 'Faith in our Future' appeal, she has said that Trinity is "committed to providing a formational and educational experience for generations to come, which includes a strong focus on the mission of the church, in line with Archbishop Philip Freier's vision for the Diocese and Province".

Trinity College Theological School needs to raise \$500,000 over a three-year period to secure its future. To do that, it is entirely dependent on the contributions of parishes such as ours, and individual parishioners. Although it is officially the theological college training clergy not just for Melbourne but for the other dioceses in Victoria, the Diocese of Melbourne has budgeted just \$100,000 for Trinity this year.

The Archbishop's 'Faith in our Future' Dinner is being held at Trinity on **Wednesday 31 August**. I will be attending, and invite you to join me in making a St John's Camberwell table. It would also be wonderful if we could present a generous amount to Professor Lee at that dinner. To that end, I invite you to make a contribution towards an overall donation from the parish via the envelopes included in today's Contact. You can either make your cheque out to 'St John's Anglican Church, Camberwell', to be combined into one parish cheque for Trinity, or, if you want to take advantage of the School's tax deductibility provision, make the cheque out to Trinity College Theological School. Either way, enclose your cheque in the envelope, and put it into the collection plate **no later than Sunday 21 August**. Cash contributions are very welcome as well, again using the envelope. Kalau tidak melakukan minum anggur dari cawan, maka disarankan untuk 'Perjamuan Kudus satu cara' yaitu makan roti saja, tanpa mencelupkan. Itu sudah dianggap sebagai Perjamuan yang penuh. Bila ada pertanyaan, silakan berbicara dengan Fr David.
