ST JOHN'S ANGLICAN CHURCH, CAMBERWELL

Third Sunday after Pentecost—25 June 2017

Today we have the first opportunity to sign the parish covenant. It has been drafted by the Churchwardens and me and approved by the Parish Council. Subsequent suggestions for amendment have been considered and incorporated as appropriate. There were few changes and a number of people have expressed their approval and acceptance of the document and the approach.

It is important to be clear what this document and signing it represents. It resembles a secular code of conduct but only in name and even then, as some have observed, we have chosen a name that is biblical in origin. Its content is vastly different from any secular agreement as it sets out how we form community together and live as the people of God, the Body of Christ. It is a touchstone that we need because we are humans. It sets a high standard for conduct of our relationships with each other. It also recognises that, being human, we are likely to fall short of its standard. So, distinct from secular agreements it might be compared to, it provides for reconciliation, that is acknowledgement of fault, repentance and forgiveness rather than offence, penalty and retribution. In this way it underscores the fact that we are created as a community distinct from secular community, sanctified, as we say. We make this covenant between each other and in the presence of God. Therefore we sign it on an altar. The implications for each of us and for our community are profound.

We hope and pray you will be prepared to join us in signing it today. There is no compulsion, there are no 'penalties' for not signing. We understand it may take time to come to a decision to commit to it with a resolved heart. So it will be always available for signing, in following weeks in association with the Sunday liturgy and thereafter, by arrangement.

We are grateful for the support and cooperation shown to us during this formative time. You are all in our prayers.
