DIVES AND LAZARUS: The archetypal rich man and poor man.

Apocalyptic literature was common in the ancient world. That strange mystical last book of the Bible, *The Revelation*, mentions the *Four Horsemen of the Apocalypse* who presage the end of the world. Doomwatchers today categorise the winding up of the Creation in modern terms because of the unignorable threats to the survival of the human race on Spaceship Earth in terms of:

1. overpopulation; 2. nuclear proliferation; 3. climate change; 4. human myopia.

Consider at the outset the looming disaster of overpopulation in the UN statistics:

World Population: 7.4 billion:

China: 1.3 billion; India: 1.2 billion; EEC 508 million; USA: 322 million; Indonesia: 258 million; Pakistan: 182 million; USSR: 146 million; Nigeria: 173 million; Japan: 126 million.....

No. of Refugees in the world: displaced, starving, ravaged by hunger and disease:

65 million!

So as you listen once again to today's Gospel on the teachings of Jesus in his culture about the rich man and the poor man, recognise that by world standards today you and I are **DIVES** at whose gate is to be found in terms of some of these statistics, **LAZARUS** our brother.

JOHN CONRAD HOWELLS: We were saddened with Tuesday's news of the death of The Reverend John Conrad Howells. John's battle with cancer was well known to us. We have admired, and been encouraged by, his courage and the strength of his faith as he has prepared himself to die. John and Helen made St John's their home in retirement years, following their move back to the city from Sorrento. But John first came to St John's around 1950, lured at first by the tennis court. John was ordained Deacon in 1960 and Priest in 1961, both in this Diocese. He is well known and respected in the Diocese for long, faithful, and significant ministry as a priest of the church, including: Curate St John Malvern East 1960-61; Curate Mitcham 1961-62; Minister Nunawading 1962-66; Incumbent West Footscray 1966-70; Curriculum Officer Council for Christian Education in Schools 1970-73; Assistant Curate Ivanhoe East 1970-79; Director Council for Christian Education in Schools 1973-82; Incumbent Ringwood 1982-89; Area Dean Croydon 1985-89; Vicar St Stephens Mt Waverley 1989-95; On Missionary Service in PNG 1995-96. We will give thanks for the ministry of John, as we mourn his death and celebrate his life tomorrow at 10.30am. We assure Helen, Clair, Stephen, Catherine and Peter, and their families, of our love and prayers. May John rest in peace; and rise with Christ in glory. *David.*
