"My Lord and my God!"

So Thomas responds to Jesus' invitation to believe. The risen Christ appears to his disciples, and Thomas (who was not present when Jesus first came into the closed room) voices a need for some physical proof, to touch, to feel the wounds of Jesus' hands and side, to know that here, surely and with no doubt, is the Jesus in whom he believes. When Christ appears a second time and speaks to them once more, Thomas' desire is granted, he is invited to touch and grasp the proofs he wished for, and Thomas responds immediately, declaring Christ as Lord and God, and affirming his faith.

While Thomas may be derided as the doubter, he reveals the deep desire in all of us for proofs and evidences by which we can make rational judgements and decisions. However faith is territory where proof cannot be provided, and our faith grows in the absence of proofs but in an instinctual belief and certainty. We all have an inner Thomas who personifies our doubts, and like the Biblical Thomas, we are all invited to make his declaration with love – proclaiming the risen Christ as our Lord and God – as we live out our Easter faith.
