Twelfth Sunday after Pentecost —27 August 2017

‘Who do you say that I am?’

Jesus' probing question to his disciples in today's Gospel is just as important today. If we asked people that question at the Camberwell Sunday market, or at a football match, what might they answer? That is, those who have heard of him. Jesus? A good man, a kind man, a good example to us, they would probably say. They might even describe him as a prophet – like Ghandi, or the Dalai Lama, perhaps. Someone to look up to, someone to inspire us, someone we can respect.

But who do *you* say that I am? Jesus persisted with his question to the disciples, and continues to probe us, his followers today. There is the world of difference between the identity given to Jesus by the general populace, and by his followers, then and now. If he is just a good man, an inspiration, an example, then we can take him or leave him, like the Sunday market shoppers, or the Galilean peasants. But if we acknowledge, with Peter, that Jesus is God's anointed one, the Son of the Living God, then our response has to be very different.

If we acknowledge that Jesus is God, we have no choice but to commit ourselves to his service as members of his own Body, which is the Church. And that is the hard part!
