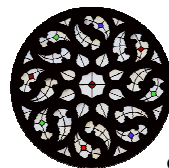

Dear Friends,

In my Lent 1 pastoral letter I expressed my thanks, for all your messages and gestures of kindness and love. Let me reiterate that today, three weeks on from my cycling misadventure. My recuperative situation is a little clearer now. After 3 weeks of 'total disablement' it's good to be back today, though preaching only, at 8am and 10am. I have to remain friends with my super-high-church collar for another 3 weeks of 'partial disablement', during which time I will only be able to manage 'light duties'. My apologies for 'those things which I ought to do' which I probably won't! In case you're wondering about the dramatic appearance, the collar is treatment for a tear in the Anterior Longitudinal Ligament (one of the two master 'rubber bands' that hold the entire spinal system together). Slow is my Lenten watchword!

Today's poem (above), by the Welsh priest/poet R S Thomas, reminds me that Lent offers a focussed time to renew and refresh that spiritual faculty we need at all times for living well: the capacity to be present, to actually be present to the moment in which we live now, to detect and discern what is truly significant (from what is not). In my case, what I had planned for Lent has been swept away by circumstances, by Life. I am required instead to 'turn aside' to a most unexpected (and unwanted!) miracle. For all of us there will be something that Life is asking us to attend to (wanted or not), to really pay attention to, to be fully present to. May we all attend deeply, 'turning aside', to the miracle of the unexpected burning bush.
