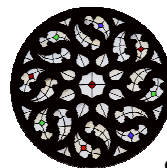

Dear Friends,

I want to express my gratitude to all who participated in last Sunday's Open Forum. It was not an easy experience, for any of us, but I believe a very important one. Today's Contact contains the Forum notes, for our further reflection and conversation. In my introduction to the Forum I explained that it would be different from earlier Forums, that I wished on this occasion to set the meeting agenda. My thanks to all who spoke, including those with opinions different from mine. I'm aware that such communal conversations are not the preferred mode for some of us, that there are many who do not speak. I'd be grateful for any suggestions as to new ways in which we can foster and encourage and broaden the kind of open discussion about our spiritual life that I'm encouraging.

The question was asked at the Forum, 'What is spirituality?' In one of the several conversations I've enjoyed since last Sunday, 'spirituality' was also raised. Much could be said about 'spirituality' (there are libraries on the subject!) In this brief space, let me merely note a few things.

Fact 1: The Bible, and in particular the Gospels and Epistles, have a great deal to say about the centrality of 'Spirit' in the life of the baptised and the mission of the church.

Fact 2: the Mission Action Plan's number one objective is 'Stimulating Spiritual Vitality'. As I have said, everything else flows from this.

Possible confusion: Conversation this week has helped me to realise that it may be that some have the perception that I have a very specific and particular kind of spirituality in mind, as a kind of 'outcome' all are meant to adopt. No, that is not the case, I assure you. For one thing, I do not think that 'outcomes' are at all crucial in the way of discipleship. In the early church we were known as people of 'The Way' – we are a pilgrim people, our spiritual *becoming* is the main event. I expect that the Spirit will motivate every single of us in very particular and unique ways. [One crucial aspect of spirituality is the very practical \(not at all esoteric!\) matter of how we relate to each other, how we argue and disagree and yet agree to move forwards.](#)

My Aim: My desire is to assist us – individually and communally – to be undergoing the Way, to be growing, developing spiritually. That's the key issue. The universe is evolving, expanding – we also are made to evolve, to expand, to deepen in our encounter with God. This does not mean despising our inheritance, but neither does it mean getting stuck – we are to be manifestations of the living Body of Christ, by the power of the Spirit.
