From Richard Wilson

As most of you know, today is, sadly, my last day in the Parish. For me, and possibly you, it is a time of reflection on what has passed in the last three years during my ministry among you. I will say something on that elsewhere so maybe you will be interested to know what happens next for me.

Tomorrow I commence work with a company called Converge International. It was once the Interchurch Trade and Industry Mission (ITIM) set up by Bp Frank Woods and Fr Lawrie Styles. Converge has evolved into a commercial, non-denominational provider of employment assistance services. I have been working with its CEO on and off for five years. He is creating a new initiative to establish a Corporate Chaplaincy practice. I will work with him on it. Don't ask what it is, we don't know yet. Suffice it to say the Boards and senior managers of businesses need pastoral care and guidance on their corporate social responsibility. We aim to work out how to do it. My formal title will be Corporate Social Counsel. We don't know what that means either!

Converge will be a half-time role for me. In the other half, I am pursuing a doctoral research program at the University of Divinity. My research project is on the theology and structure of Church mission in the business community.

Finally, next Sunday, I am taking up an honorary assistant appointment at St Peter's East Melbourne. As I go, I wish you all the very best and my prayers for you. Please pray, also, for me.
